

RULES OF SQUASH

RULE 12 – INTERFERENCE

SUMMARY

OUTGOING PLAYER MUST MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO GIVE OPPONENT:

FAIR VIEW OF THE BALL
(as it comes off the front wall)
DIRECT ACCESS TO THE BALL
(once a reasonable follow through is completed)
FREEDOM TO PLAY THE BALL
(with a reasonable swing)
TO THE ENTIRE FRONT WALL

INCOMING PLAYER MUST MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO GET TO AND PLAY THE BALL

No Interference	No Let
Insufficient effort made to clear	Stroke
Incoming Player could not have reached the ball or was making minimal or no effort to do so	No Let
Every effort to clear was made and interference was minimal	No Let
Every effort was made to clear and no winning shot was possible	Let
Every effort to clear made, but clearance path inadvertently impeded the opponent, resulting in total failure to provide one of the 4 requirements noted above	Stroke
Every effort to clear made, but winning shot prevented	Stroke
Incoming player moved past the point of interference before calling the let	No let
