2019 8 WING/CFB TRENTON INTERSECTION GOLF LEAGUE BY-LAWS

210.1 GENERAL

- a. Play shall be IAW the Royal Canadian Golf association and the by-laws listed below.
- b. Where the RCGA rules and the by-laws differ, the by-laws shall be the final authority.
- c. All matches will be 9 holes and played at the Roundel Glen Golf Course.
- d. Teams starting on the front or back 9 will stay on the front or back 9.
- e. Roundel Glen Golf Course local rules and regulations (**including dress code**) will be strictly enforced (no jeans or shirt with out a collar).
- f. Each team shall take a maximum of double par on any one hole.

210.2 TEAM COMPOSITION

Team composition shall be as follows:

- a) Each team must be departmental in nature;
- b) Each team will have a minimum of 10 players on their nominal roll;
- c) Every member of the I/S Golf League must be registered with the Mil Sports Coord. Civilians & class A reservists off duty as well as their Commanding Officer must sign the liability waiver and return it to the Mil Sports Coord;
- d) Players who are posted in during the regular season will be eligible to play but must complete a registration form to be added to the official team list kept by the Mil Sports Coord;
- e) Registered players may not go to other teams without permission from the league, and cannot sub in on other teams at any time. Players must play with the team in which he/she is registered;
- f) Players must have played a minimum of 2 regular season games to be eligible to play in the year end; and

210.3 MATCH

- a. Match will be a 2 X 2-player scramble match play format over 9 holes for a total of 18 holes. The team with the lowest score will be declared winner of the hole;
- b. Play is "Best Ball". There may only be 1 club length between balls, with no change in cut:
- c. The team winning the most holes wins the match. A single player can play against a team of 2 players but can only play 1 ball;
- d. Other players (even if registered) from another unit cannot play for a different unit. If a player plays for a different unit, they will automatically forfeit that twosome;
- e. Points awarded for match are as follow: win=3 pts, tie=2 pts, loss=1 pt

210.4 TEE-OFF AND SIGN IN

Tee-off will be a shot gun start. Each member is responsible to report to the registration table (located outside on the patio) prior to tee-off.

- a. Tee off is scheduled every Tuesdays for 13:00hrs;
- b. The registration table will be open from 12:15-13:00hrs;
- c. Civilian & class A reservist off duty will pay their \$10.00 green fees to the Mil Sports Coord during registration time.

210.5 SCORE CARDS

The score card is the responsibility of both teams, (i.e.) each team should acknowledge the other team's score.

- a. The card will have units and date printed neatly.
- b. All scorecards must be signed by both teams (signifying that the score is correct) and the captain of the winning team will be responsible to turn in the card to the pro shop.
- c. The card will be scored as W (win), L (loss), T (tie) per hole not strokes.
- d. Scorecards that are not received by the Mil Sports Coord will result in a loss to the offending teams.

210.6 MATCH CANCELLATION

If a team needs to cancel a game, the team representative must e-mail the team representative of the opposite team that their team was scheduled to play against as well as the Mil Sports Coord a minimum of 24 hours before the match. The opposite team will by default. The opposite team is still allowed to put 4 golfers and play a round of golf as per the schedule

a. If a team does not contact the opposite team representative as well as the Mil Sport Coord 24 hours prior, the Mil Sports Coord will notify the CoC of the offending team.

210.7 MATCHES CANCELLED/CALLED DUE TO WEATHER

- a. Regardless of the weather conditions, teams must be present at Roundel Glen Golf Course for their scheduled tee time unless said otherwise by the Mil Sports Coord. Intersection matches *Will Not Proceed* if the Roundel Glen Golf Course is closed. If the weather is completely un-cooperative (thunder, lightening, tornado, etc.) after teams teed off, the pro shop staff will sound the horn to clear the course for *safety reasons*. All teams are to leave the golf course.
- b. In the event that the weather becomes unfavorable after a match has commenced and at least one (1) hole has been completed, the scorecard shall be turn in to the pro shop at the Roundel Glen Golf Course, signed and attested by a member from both teams, and annotated "Match Called Due To Weather". The match will be recorded (win/loss/tie) based upon the completed holes to that point.
- b. Matches that are canceled before a hole has been played will not be counted in the league stats (i.e. No Win, Loss, Tie, or Default will be recorded).
- c. Protests concerning matches affected by this rule must be submitted in writing to the I/S Golf League president, within 48 hours of the scheduled match.

210.7 TIE BREAKER/STANDINGS

- a. Team standings at year end will be decided by the cumulative of points earned during the regular season.
- b. If there is a tie in the standings between 2 teams at the end of the regular season, it will be broken by:
 - a) most wins; then
 - b) head to head record

210.8 TIE BREAKER DURING THE PLAYOFFS

If there is a tie at the end of 9 holes during the playoffs or after 18 holes during the year end tournament, teams will choose two golfers each to play best ball sudden death holes.
