1.0 Call to Order:

The 2023 Annual General Meeting for Winnipeg Military Family Resource Centre (WMFRC) was called to order at 6:10 p.m. with quorum being declared.

2.0 Land Acknowledgement, Welcome & Opening Remarks:

The Chairperson recognized that the Winnipeg MFRC provide services, programs and support to military members and their families on the ancestral lands of the Anishinaabeg, Cree, Oji-Cree, Dakota and Dené peoples and on the traditional homeland of the Métis Nation. She also recognized that the Thunder Bay MFRC provides services, programs and support to military members and their families on the traditional lands of the members of the Fort William First Nation, signatories to the Robinson-Superior Treaty in 1850, and the Métis people.

8.0 Annual Report 2022-2023

Allison Payne, the WMFRC Executive Director, opened her remarks with thanks to all the staff and volunteers who helped to produce the report. She also thanked the staff at the Thunder Bay Satellite Office.

After voicing her appreciation to staff and volunteers, Allison proceeded with summarizing the 2022-2023 year.

- The WMFRC has hired Jessica Jones as the Client Care Coordinator.
- WMFRC Staff are key to providing one-on-one services to military members and military families.
- Spousal employment remains a challenge. A self-serve, spousal employment hub may be found on the Canadian Forces Morale and Welfare Services (CFMWS) website at https://cfmws.ca/support-services/employment.
- Second language learning is currently supported using Rosetta Stone licenses.
- Child and youth mental health needs continue to be addressed. Stefy Reed and Jenny Brennan collaborated on the development of a youth survival kit.
- The requirement for affordable and accessible childcare continues to be a concern for many families. Winnipeg's MFRC Childcare Centre, now under the direction of Kendra Martin, supports the care of 123 children per annum. The Nursery School also ran at full capacity.
- Later in the year, the WMFRC hired Tamika Reid to be the Community Services Advisor and the Veteran Family Program Coordinator. Tamika is currently developing programs to assist people with separation due to military service and to facilitate reintegration.



8.0 Annual Report 2022-2023 (Cont'd)

Allison's presentation also included the following points:

- The WMFRC Family Liaison Officer, Kim Smyrski, assisted 69 clients this year and has undertaken the responsibility to provide professional development and support to Transition Centre members. She also assisted two military families with emergency funding this past fiscal year.
- Stefy Reed, our Child & Family Social Worker has assisted 94 clients this fiscal year. She has also noted an increase in demand for services from couples.
- The definition of family is expanding beyond blood relatives and married/common-inlaw relations. Families now include anyone a CAF member considers to be family including close friends.
- The Strategic Planning sessions held with Harris Leadership Strategies earlier in the year were successful in highlighting five priorities, identifying strategic gaps, and reaffirming the need to leverage community resources and engage in further outreach.

At the conclusion of Allison's remarks, Stephanie thanked her for her dedication to the organization and for all her hard work. The WMFRC Administrative Assistant, Second Language Training Coordinator and Receptionist, Carole Matiowsky, was also commended for her hard work and flexibility.

A motion was made to accept the WMFRC Annual Report for the 2022-2023 fiscal year as presented.

A special thank you was reserved for Irene Wyrozub who has served as the Thunder Bay Advisory Council Representative for over six years.
