Emergency Contact

- Displayed and up to date with, Name and Contact Information
- Boat owner or delegate to inspect their boat at least once per month and after winds of 30 kts or more.

Docking

- Fenders in sufficient amount and in good condition
- Berthing lines, min of 4 lines (2 x Spring/ 1 x Bow/ 1 x Stern) all in good condition
- All equipment secured/tied down

Insurance

- Maintain adequate marine insurance while at the dock IAW club policy.

Remarks:

Electrical

- 30 Amp shore power cable in good repair, 1 per boat
- One cable per outlet (unless using a marine grade splitter and lock collar or taped)
- Boat A/C circuit breaker operational
- Stray/drop voltage check (to be carried out by foreshore)
- Bilge pump in good repair (auto and manual)
- 1 Heater per boat, not to exceed 1500 Watts

Fire protection

- Fire Extinguishers (proper amount, class and type for boat length) NOT EXPIRED

Dinghy (Tender)

- On davits or, on the foreshore (above the high-water line) adjacent to the clubhouse or, on the east side of "G" float and maintained in good condition.
